



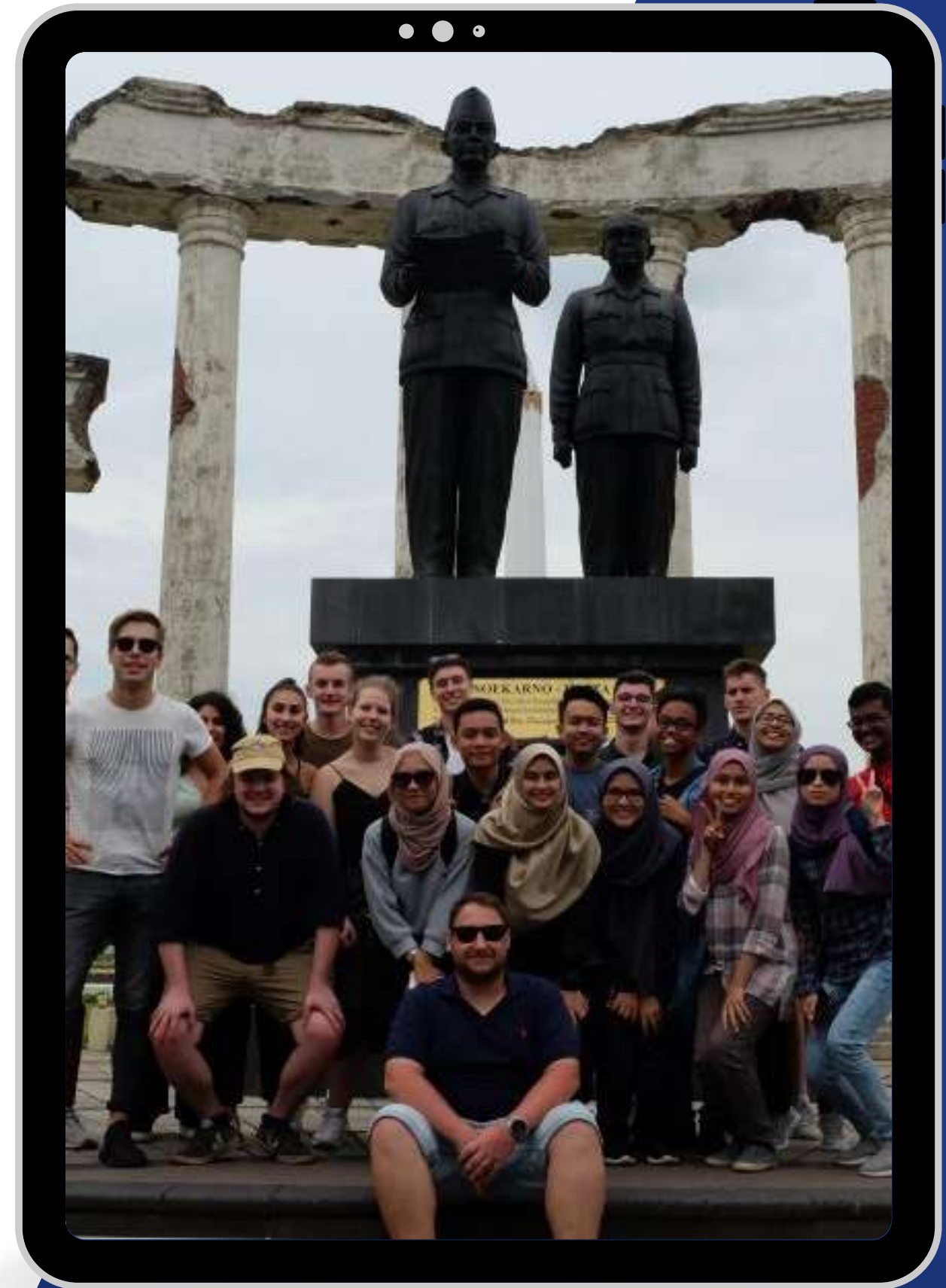

Fun Bahasa Indonesia and Cultural Course Program (FBICC) - virtual

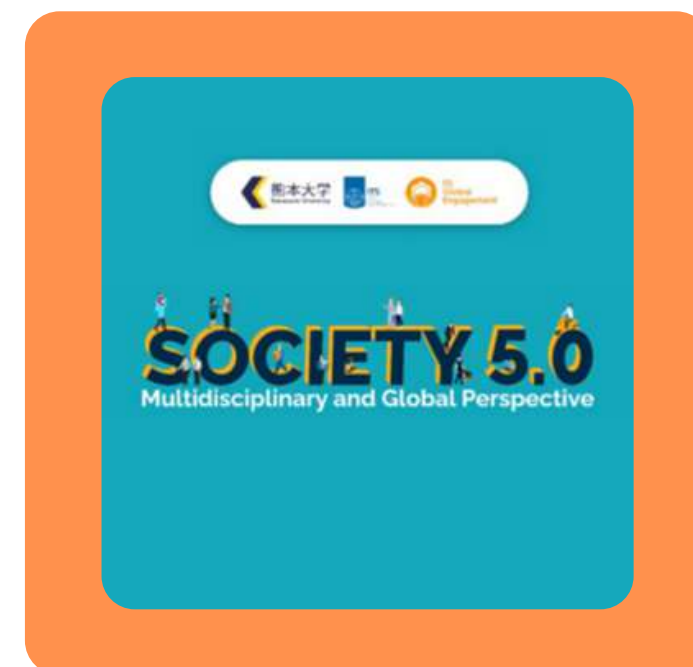

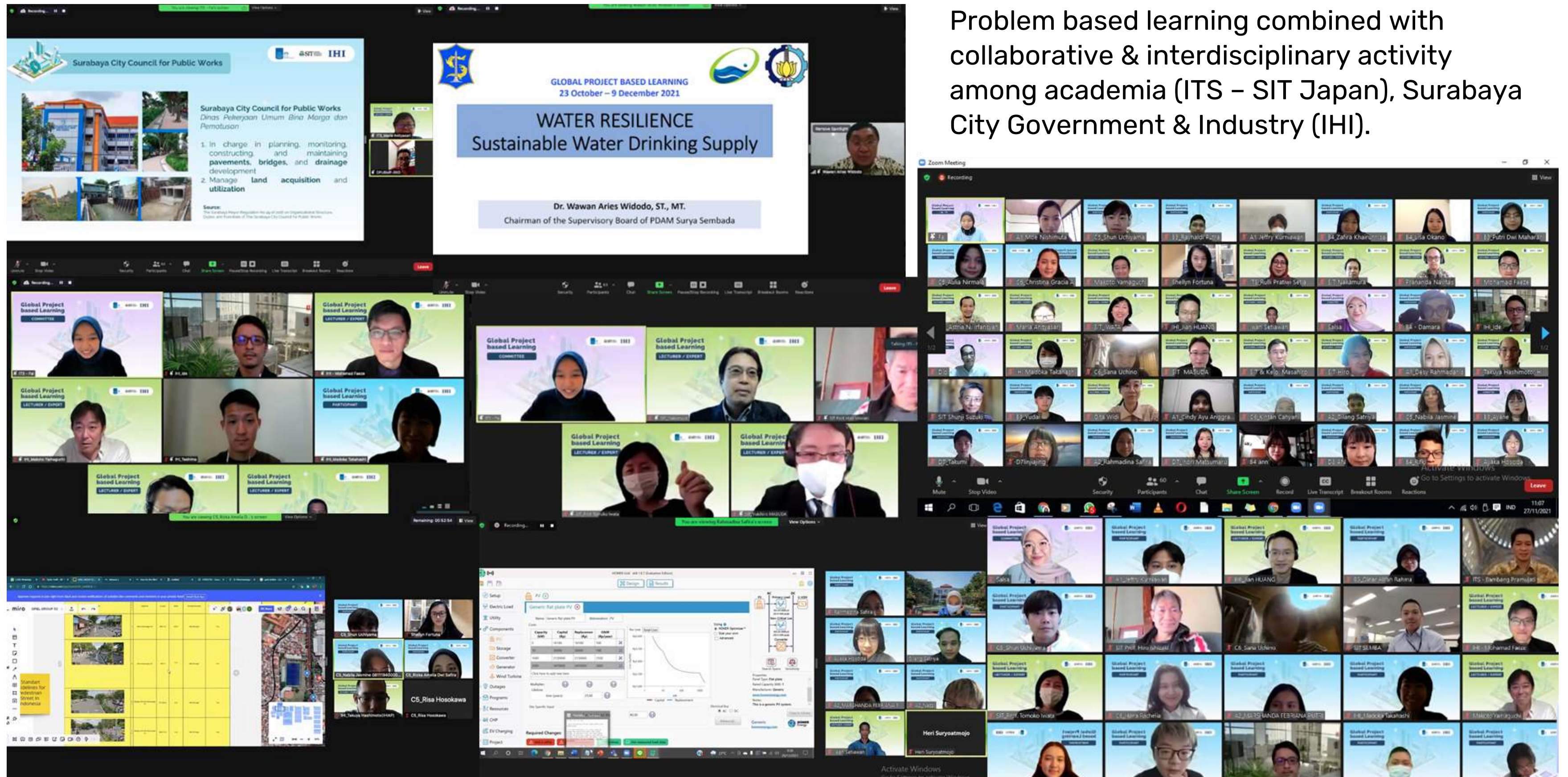
Customized Short Programs

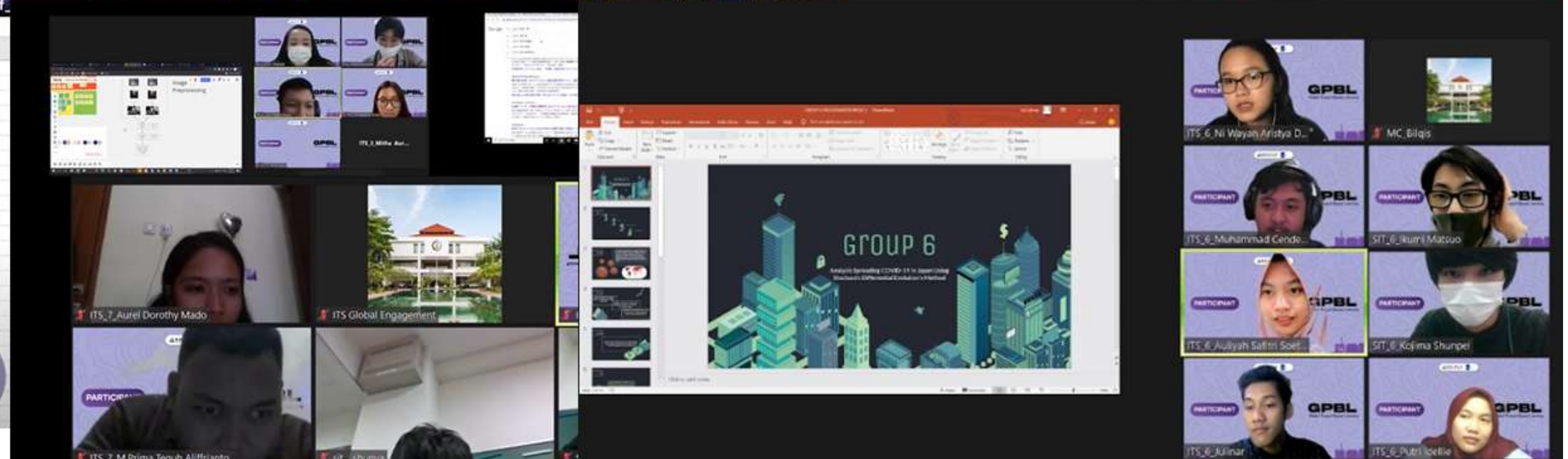
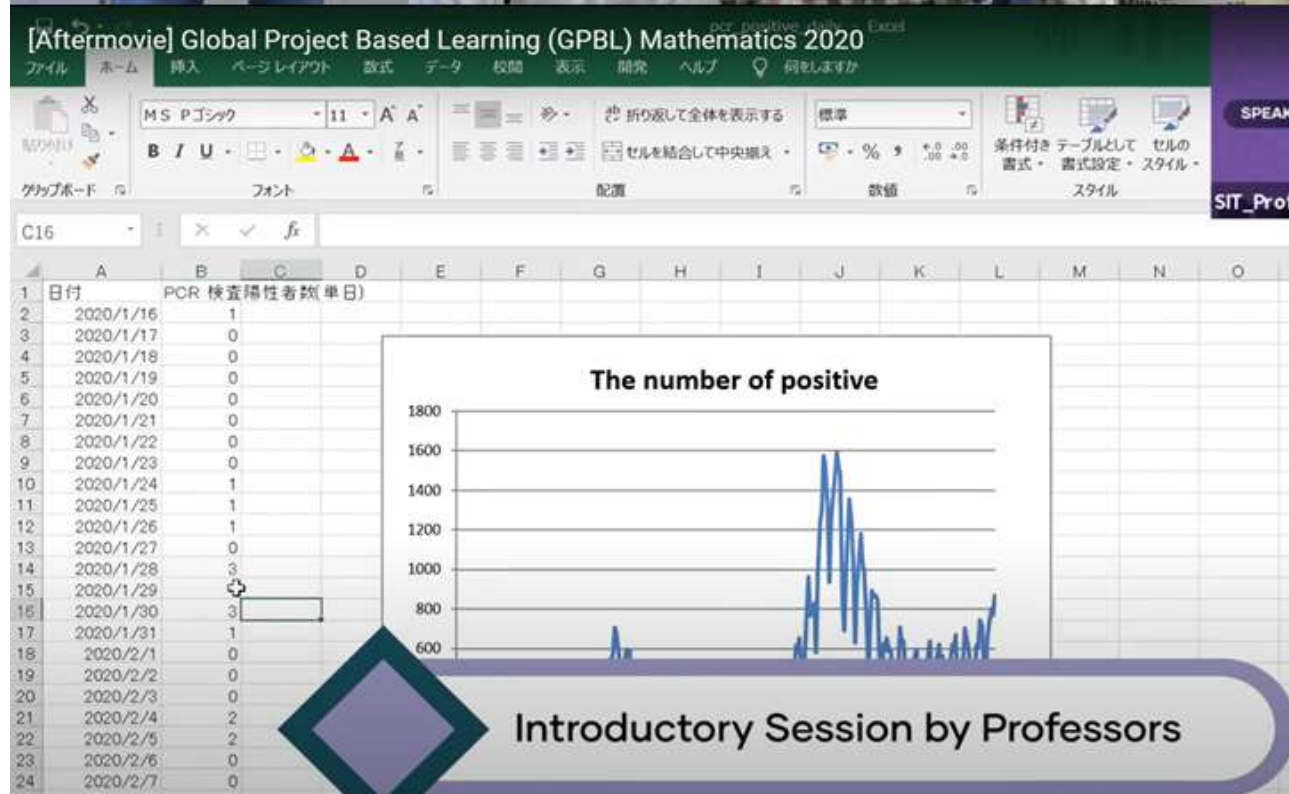
Successful Program Global Project Based Learning ITS-SIT-IHI

ITS' WCP-like program provides funding for overseas professors to come to ITS Surabaya, Indonesia.

Outcomes
